LAND POOLING POLICY

No. 5140 SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS may pleased to refer to Unstarred Question No. 2493 dated 02.01.2018 regarding 'Land Pooling Policy' and state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to extend the Land Pooling Policy to P1 zone;

(b) if so, the details thereof indicating the names of the villages to be covered thereunder and the time by which the policy is likely to be notified for P1 zone; and

(c) if not, the alternate policy being considered for planned development in the said zone and to initiate steps to allow construction of residential units therein?
